

**ALL GENDER HOUSING AGREEMENT**

1. I understand that (1) all gender housing is defined as a housing option in which two or more students share a multiple-occupancy apartment or suite, in mutual agreement, regardless of the students' sex, gender, gender identity, and gender expression and (2) that the intent of this agreements to give students the option to reside with another person of a different gender or gender marker in order to provide a welcoming living environment, and (3) allows/encourages students who identify as transgender and gender nonconforming, students I the process of discovering their gender identity, students who identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual, pansexual, asexual or queer, and students who feel more comfortable with a roommate of a different gender the option to find a more compatible roommate and living situation within this community.
2. In order to be eligible for all gender housing, I must adhere to the housing application and deposit deadlines and receive a lottery number (upperclassmen) or be approved by the Housing and Residential Life (new incoming student).
3. I understand that if I exhibit behavior that is contrary to the spirit of this agreement I may be relocated to a different housing accommodation on campus.
4. I understand that a wide variety of gender housing options will be available to students wishing to live in an all gender environment; however, there will be limited number designated by room type and rate.
5. If my apartment/suitemate(s) cancel their housing or moves out of the room for any reason, the remaining roommate(s) must identify a new roommate (s) to fill the vacancy. The Housing and Residential Life will define the time allocated to find a new roommate. This window of time will vary depending on time of year and the status of the housing waitlist. Typically, a resident will be allowed a minimum of 24 hours, but not more than one week to identify another eligible roommate. IF a roommate(s) is not identified to fill the vacancy within the time period, Housing and Residential Life reserves the right to: (1) assign any student who indicates they are interested in living in all gender housing, (2) assign a student of the same sex or (3) relocate/consolidate the current resident(s) to a different all gender space that meets their needs. Room types cannot be guaranteed if a student is moved.
6. Housing and Residential Life has the right to consolidate all gender spaces as needed.
7. It is the student's choice to communicate with parents or family members about the decision to live in an all gender housing options.
